

2022 Ozark and Heart of America Beefmasters Spring Sale Bull Test Information

The 2021 / 2022 OHOA Bull Test will be held at Day Cattle Company in Inola, Oklahoma. Carl Day ran the bull test for OHOA for several years in the past and has agreed to take it on again.

Delivery will be December 11th, 2021, weather permitting with December 18th as an alternate. The coordinator for this test will be Mike Moss, you can also contact Roger Holden. Please contact Mike or Roger on or before November 1st, 2021, if you would like to consign bulls. You will need to bring a copy of your certificate with you as the originals will be mailed with your nomination paperwork for the spring sale.

All eligible bulls should be born between January 1, 2020, thru October 31, 2020. All bulls need to have an official 205-day weight from BBU and have been ultra-sounded within the 320 and 500 day of age range. If not polled, bulls should have horns removed if they are over 1/2 inch in length.

Each consigner can bring as many animals as they want but ONLY the top 40 bulls will sell. The top 40 will be determined by the 3 following categories and each will account for 1/3rd of overall score for each animal.

1. Average daily gain while on test.
2. Weight per day of age
3. Visual score at end of test

\$125 nomination fee will be required at delivery per animal and consigner must be an OHOA and BBU member. The \$125 nomination fee will be used to purchase the original feed but WILL be credited back to your feed bill by the end of the test. Day Cattle Co will bill monthly, and all feed bills will be handled by Day Cattle Co only. No sales management will have any role in the billing of feed. Day Cattle Co will get \$1.00 per head per day plus feed costs.

All bulls will be screened at delivery by the OHOA Bull committee.

Reasons for excluding any animal will be as follows,

1. Feet Issues
2. Muzzle Issues
3. Overall disposition
4. Any issue that will affect Marketability

Make sure all animals are up to date on worming and vaccinations. Test tags will be provided and put in on delivery where they will get their starting weight.

We will be using the ration used for years by Carl. The bulls grew well from this ration and were ready for the sale by the end of the test. Feed costs are going to be expensive this year as we all well know but will be kept down as much as possible.

When we get a complete list of consignors, we will send out the delivery address, along with Day Cattle Co address.
